NEWS FROM WHAT'S HAPPENING ON NORTH STREET!

Despite having been open for less than 4 years we are already actively looking at extending our building!

We certainly didn't expect to be looking at a building project so soon in our life.

Over the past year we have been delighted to welcome a larger proportion of our volunteer team who have additional support needs. This has put additional pressure on an already too small kitchen preparation area, and meant we have had to limit the number and scope of volunteers with additional support needs simply due to space.

At the same time we have been running a group for LGBTQ+ teenagers and have a couple of regular customers who are dealing with gender identity issues. This has led us to realise that we need to make our toilets non gender specific and we now have plans to reorder the toilet area into unisex cubicles which will also free up some much needed storage space. We feel this is an area which often the church lags behind in, so are pleased to be taking a lead in making our toilets gender neutral as a positive expression of our Christian values.
